Drop off Time

The reason we are particular about the students being at school by 8.45am is because the children's presentations have commenced by that time. It can be very unsettling for students who arrive later than 8.45am as they have to enter the classroom by themselves, seeing that everyone is already settled. Also they may miss out on lessons already started if they arrive late. Arrivals after 8.45am can also be disruptive to students already in the class, especially in Cycle 1 – their concentration is broken by their friend entering the class after they have settled.

**Please ensure that drop off is before 8.45am. This means that students are settled and in lessons at 8.45am.

Lunches

Please note that if your child is attending the Afternoon programme **their lunches need to remain in their school bags**. Please provide an ice block/pack for refrigeration of their lunches.

SIGN IN

If you wish for your child to attend the afternoon programme please ensure that you sign them in for the programme on the sign in book at your classroom door. Place an AP if your child requires the programme. This enables us to effectively collect the children who are attending the programme for that particular day and ensures that the correct sign in process is being adhered to. Thank you.

PLAYGROUND AREA

It is important that the playground area of Cycle 1 is vacated immediately at pick up. This enables the Afternoon Programme to access the playground for play and ensures that during lunchtime play we have effective security with the opening and closing of the playground gates. In order to maintain our Community spirit please make use of the picnic tables made available in the Casuarina Grove if required. Once again supervision needs to be maintained.
