

Key points about enrolment

Preschool/Primary School

- The Montessori programme starts at or as close as possible to a child's third birthday (enrolments occur throughout the year) and continues until the end of primary school (Year 6).
- *Children over the age of 3 years 3 months cannot usually be enrolled unless transferring from another Montessori school. Older children may be considered in exceptional circumstances on a case by case basis.*
- Children must be toilet trained before starting at the school.
- A place on the waiting list does not guarantee a place in the school.
- Places are subject to an interview with the Principal.
- We ask both parents to make a time to have a tour of the school, observe in a classroom prior to enrolment and to familiarize themselves with the Montessori philosophy of education.
- Please note that Canberra Montessori School is not a day care centre but a school educating children from 3 to 12 years of age.

To go on the waiting list for the school you will need to submit, with the appropriate fees, the following:

CMS Membership form (annual fee of \$60)
Application for Registration form (\$120 per child)

Parent Toddler Programme

- This programme is for children aged 18 mths to 3 years, attending for 2 hours one day a week with a parent/carer.
- Where limited places are available, preference is given to children registered on the waiting list for the pre/primary school Montessori programme
- Attendance in the Parent Toddler Programme does not guarantee a place in the pre/primary school.
- We ask that you make a time to observe in the PTP classroom before enrolment.

To go on the waiting list for the Parent Toddler Programme you will need to submit, with the appropriate fees, the following:

CMS Membership form (annual fee of \$60)

Payment Options: We do not have credit card or EFTPOS facilities. *Payment must be by cheque or cash.* Once registered with the school, any subsequent payments can be made by BPay.
